Thursday, November 8th, 2018

13:00 Arrival of participants from Moldova and Ukraine, transfer from Airport Düsseldorf to Hotel Ibis Bonn (Vorgebirgsstr. 33)

14:15 Exhibition opening of „The Library of Rescued Memories“. MKG teachers and their students present their outcomes of working with the exhibition during the school project days

18:00 Participants will attend the commemorative speech at the site of the former synagogue and join the silent march to Junges Theater Bonn where students will present their memorial projects
